Do you know where this 14-year-old is?

(Homosassa) Citrus County Sheriff's Office detectives are asking for the public's help in locating a missing 14-year-old Homosassa girl who reportedly ran away from her Sugarmill Woods home two weeks ago.

Rachael Anne Warren's mother told deputies that the last time she saw her daughter was on Friday, Aug. 28, around 10:30 p.m., when the girl was in her bedroom. The teen's mother checked on her a little later and found that the girl was no longer in the residence. She reported her as missing on Aug. 29. It's unknown at this time what Rachael may have been wearing the night she ran away from home.

Rachael is a white female, 5 feet 3 inches tall and weighs 105 pounds. She has hazel eyes and may have cut and dyed her long brown hair.

This frequent runaway's information has been entered into the national database for missing persons, and deputies have been issued a BOLO (be on the lookout) as well as her photo. (See photo attached.)
