Trying to Ascertain Woman's Well-Being

(Citrus County) Citrus County Sheriff's Office detectives are hoping that the woman in the attached photo looks familiar to someone here in the county.

Dispatchers received a call just before 1 a.m. on Tuesday, Sept. 8, from a female caller who claimed she was being battered. She hung up before providing any additional information, and attempts to reach her again via her cell phone number failed.

Further investigation revealed that the phone was registered to Jean Marie Doerr, 45, with an address in Volusia County. Law enforcement there tried locating her without success. Another address in Bradford County turned out to be a dead end as well.

Doerr is described as being 5 feet 2 inches tall, weighing 105 pounds and having blue eyes and brown or blonde hair.

Citrus County deputies responded to all of Doerr's known local addresses, but the woman was nowhere to be found. Contact also was made with area hospitals and urgent care facilities; however, Doerr had not been seen by any of them.

A local and regional BOLO (be on the lookout) was issued for Doerr, and her limited information was entered into the national database in hopes of determining her location and well-being.
