When discovered, Owens was fully clothed and wearing a large amount of jewelry. The suspect(s) may be close associates. Ms. Owens was last seen alive on 9-25-02. The investigation revealed that Debra Owens death was the result of a homicide.

Although convictions have been made for Conspiracy to Commit Murder, the body of Daniel Sites has not yet been recovered. Information is still needed as to the location of Daniels Sites body. Mr. Crawford's death has been listed as a homicide due to gunshot. He was last seen around 1:00 a.m. at a bar in Crystal River, Florida. At the time he was last seen he had a large amount of cash. When his body was recovered he had only \$21.00 on his person. Mr. Crawford was last seen on 5-3-86 at approximately 1:00 A.M. at the Crystal Lounge on Hwy 44 E. in Crystal River.</p> <p><b>Please contact the Criminal Investigation Division if you have information regarding this case.</b></p>

The vehicle she allegedly left in was located at the Bayfront Center in St. Pete on 7/27/81. At the time of her disappearance, Mrs. Coker resided in Beverly Hills. She has had no contact with any family members since her disappearance.
